Chicago History Museum Parking

Public parking is conveniently located one block north of the Museum at Clark and LaSalle Streets. Enter on Stockton Drive. The secure, well-lit parking facility is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The lot can accommodate up to 460 cars.

Accessibility

Specially located spots have been reserved for persons using mobility devices.



Self-Parking

Event guests may self-park in the parking lot. Upon entering or exiting the museum, attendees may have their tickets validated at the front desk. The validated rate is \$11.00 per vehicle for 24 hours.

Hosted Parking

If you would like to provide parking for your guests, you may purchase passes at \$11.00 each. A credit card needs to be provided and will be kept on file, at least ten days prior. The balance must be received 3 business days following the event. We do require a credit card on file for this service.

For hosted parking, guests self-park in the lot. Parking passes are distributed at the event, and then used by the guests to exit.

Driving Directions

From the North

Take the Kennedy (I-90/94) to the North Avenue exit. Travel east on North Avenue two miles to Clark Street.

From the West

Take the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) to the Kennedy (I-90/94). Take the Kennedy to the North Avenue exit. Travel east on North Avenue two miles to Clark Street.

From the South

Take the Dan Ryan (I-90/94). Continue on the Kennedy (I-90/94). Take the Kennedy to the North Avenue exit. Travel east on North Avenue two miles to Clark Street. or, take the Dan Ryan (I-90/94) to the Stevenson (I-55). Take the Stevenson to Lake Shore Drive. Travel north on Lake Shore Drive to North Avenue exit. Travel west on North Avenue/LaSalle two blocks to Clark Street.
