

Alan Mills is the Executive Director of the Uptown People's Law Center, where he represents prisoners throughout the state prison system. Alan began working at UPLC in 1979 as a law student volunteer, and has worked there in one capacity or another ever since. He made his first visit to an Illinois prison in 1982, and has been visiting prisoners ever since. UPLC currently has six class action cases against the Illinois Department of Corrections, including cases about medical care, mental health care, and the excessive use of solitary. Of particular relevance to our discussion this evening is a case he recently concluded challenging the way that the Illinois Department of Corrections and the Prisoner Review Board handled parole revocations.
